2. Tell Kathleen or Karen (we want to help you!).


3. Recruit neighbors on your alley to help—especially the kids


a. Encourage everyone to pick a project for their property (plant flowers, paint a picture on the garage or fence, hang art, make up-cycled art from throw-aways)



If we have Nextdoor and Facebook, why do we need a neighborhood association?

There is power in numbers and organized effort. The North City Park Civic Association (NCPCA) is a Registered Neighborhood Organization (RNO). When Denver City Government (Councilors and Mayor) sends official communications regarding neighborhood issues, they send them to RNOs. The communication goes the other way, too. When City Government wants to hear from the neighborhood, they often approach our RNO, the NCPCA. To increase your chance of being heard, connect with your RNO, the NCPCA.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Throughout its 35-year history, NCPCA has obtained new street lights & dumpsters, led neighborhood cleanups and graffiti patrols, pushed for getting alleys paved and sidewalk improvements, forced crack houses to shut down, hosted annual neighborhood festivals, and actively participated in discussions concerning re-development of the old YMCA property at 31st and Madison.


